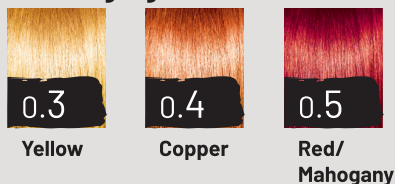

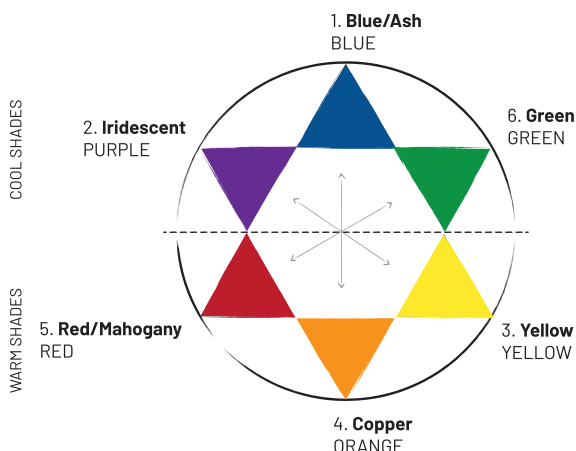

How to neutralise unwanted highlights?



Primary colours and their complementary shades oppose and neutralise one another.

- To neutralise a green background, apply a .5 Red/Mahogany
- To neutralise an orange background, apply a .1 Blue/Ash
- To neutralise a yellow background, apply a .2 Iridescent (purple)

Diagnosis

Before choosing a fundamental colour and possibly a chromatic shade, carry out a **good diagnosis** is essential by asking yourself **the following questions**:

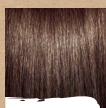

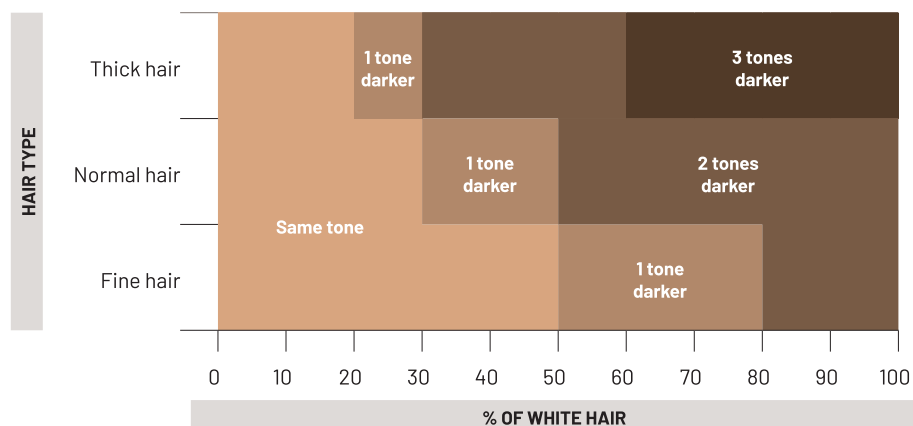

Choosing the right tone*



*Table valid except to obtain a light blonde 10.0, 9.0, 8.0. In this case we always keep the same tone 8.0.

Example I would like to get a 5.0 on normal hair with 60% white hair

> I choose 2 tones darker, i.e. a 3.0 as a fundamental shade.

Note

Color One® tends to bring out the natural pigmentation of the hair.

Color One® cannot be used to lighten hair.

All the colouring products have the same dark visual appearance. But this does not affect the final colour.

2 Preparing the mixture

Blends proposed for a base of 50g

The first digit indicates the depth of colour

The first digit after the point refers to the main highlight

The second digit after the point refers to the secondary highlight

Example: 7.35

To create a warm or cool highlight or to neutralise an unwanted hue, use a chromatic shade



Wear suitable gloves.
Shake the tube before use.



In a bowl, pour the fundamental colour only or mix with the chosen chromatic shade. Mix well.

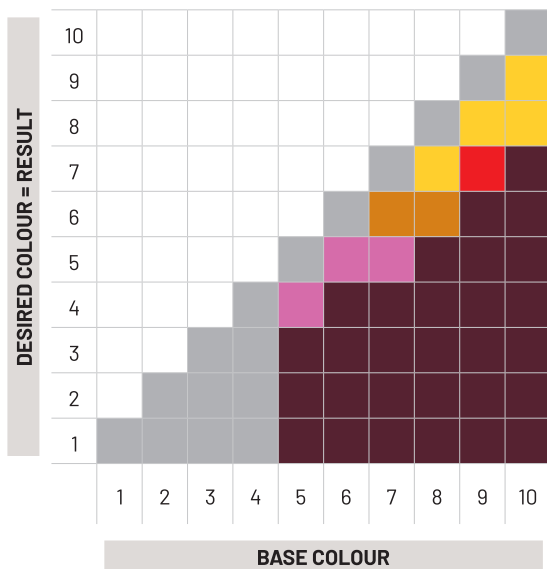

3 Preparing the hair







- **If needed**, exfoliate the hair:
 - If the treatment the hair has received acts as a barrier to the dyeing process,
 - In case of excess sebum.

• **In all cases**, use a pigment shampoo or a silicone-free alkaline shampoo to open the hair scales and promote the dyeing process. Towel dry the hair.

• **In cases where your client wishes to darken their hair colour** a colour lift or a pre-colour will be required (see below).



If the hair are highlighted, lightest hair tone.

-  No pre-colour, no colour lift.

Example:

The customer has blonde highlights, tone 10 (extremely light blond), and she wants to return to her natural colour which is a 6 (dark blonde):

- Apply the Pigment hair care Ombre Naturelle (Natural warm brown) or Marron Glacé (Glossy chestnut brown) to all her highlights. Leave for 5 minutes. Do not rinse.
- Then apply the Color One® No. 6.0 from the roots to the tips. Leave for 40 minutes wrapped in cellophane and rinse.

Colour lift

Technique

- > When pulling the colour to the tips, select the appropriate warm or cool shade from the Patrice Mulato Pigment cream hair care®
- > Add 2 to 3 pump presses of the selected shade into the remaining Color One® hair colouring
- > Apply from mid-length to the tips



Pre-colour

Technique

Use the Patrice Mulato Pigment cream hair care®

- > Work the lengths and tips with the Pigment cream hair care® of your choice, strand by strand
- > Massage well and detangle the strands as you go for an even pigment distribution
- > Do not rinse or leave to stand. Apply the Color One® hair colouring on the roots, lengths, tips



4 Application on washed en towel-dried hair



Apply generously the colour with a brush on the roots. Start applying the colour from the top of the head, sectioning the hair into thin strands (for the n°7.0 and 8.0 start from the vertex).

For maximum effectiveness, do not spread the coloring.



If needed, apply on the lengths and tips (see colour pulling chart below).



Cover the hair with a plastic film. For optimal coverage, use a Climazon.

Note

A colour doesn't always need to be pulled through the lengths and tips. To do so, it is sometimes better to use a Pigment hair care

Emulsifying and rinsing



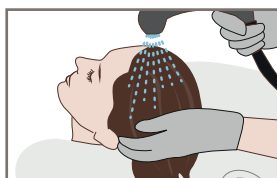
Remove the plastic film from the hair.



Massage the scalp to remove the colour.



Trickle water gently and emulsify.



Rinse until the water runs clear.



Apply the Color One® Patrice Mulato post-colour shampoo (one shampoo is enough).



If needed, finish with the Patrice Mulato mask for coloured hair.

FAQs

What are the main differences between Color One® and a traditional hair colour?

Color One® is not an oxidative hair colouring. Formulated with over 90% of natural ingredients, it does not contain harsh chemicals such as resorcin or (PPD) diamines. It does not distort the hair fibre as the pigments are simply applied onto the surface of the fibre.

Should I mix the natural hair colour with an oxidant?

No, Color One® is ready to use and requires no mixing with an oxidiser. This hair colour will not lighten the hair.

My customer's hair is 100% grey. Will the hair colour take?

Yes, and depending on the diagnosis, a fundamental 2 or 3 shades darker than the required result should be chosen. For example, a client with fine hair wanting a 6, I would choose a 4.0. See table on page 7.

If my customer already has an oxidative hair colour, can I apply a Color One® hair colour?

Yes, you can apply Color One®, that's not a problem. Similarly, it is compatible with tone-on-tone or vegetal hair colouring and with all available hairdressing techniques (perm, straightening...).

How is it possible that without an oxidant, PPD or resorcin, grey hair is coloured?

Our NATURAL COLOR PROCESS® technology guarantees excellent coverage of grey hair with the combination of natural ingredients and innovative dyes that optimise the colouring.

How long does the Color One® colouring last?

Color One® has a resistance similar to oxidative hair colours, i.e. between 6 and 7 weeks (depending on the number of shampoos).

Can Color One® be compared to vegetal hair colours?

Yes, they are similar. However, Color One® is easier to use, results in more shades and less artificial highlights. Color One® is also compatible with other dyes, unlike vegetable hair dyes. Furthermore, Color One® requires a shorter time to develop and offers a much wider choice of shades than vegetable hair colouring.

Can I apply the chromatic shades directly, for example on a bleaching?

Yes, that's not a problem. However, you must watch out for the length of times used for developing the colour (between 5 and 30 minutes).

If a customer wants to stop dyeing her hair, should she first dye her hair the same colour as her natural hair colour to avoid a "root effect"?

No, she can stop colouring her hair at any time. Color One® colouring fades naturally when shampoo without leaving a root effect.
